This workshop is designed for people with some experience of undertaking analysis of texts using systemic functional grammar. The aim is to extend participants' skills in discourse analysis by exploring ways in which to move from the findings of grammatical analyses to semantic characterisations of the significant patterns in a text. A range of analytical frameworks will be drawn on, including Hasan's semantic networks (1996). We will show how the process of systematically inter-relating analyses at the lexicogrammatical and semantic strata produces a more coherent account of the text in its social context than can be achieved through analysis located in one stratum only. We will discuss in some detail the key methodological issue of how to map semantic resources so that they can be related to lexicogrammatical ones. Participants will be encouraged to bring their own analyses for further exploration and discussion. The presenter will also provide analyses from a range of registers – including literary texts, academic writing, business texts, and interactive oral discourse – as the basis for discussion. The texts for analysis will be predominantly in English.
