Corpus Linguistics has been used in a range of different domains, from dictionary making, to forensic analysis and translation. One of the early applications of corpora has been in language teaching and learning, because corpora naturally require viewing language through authentic samples of language use, which should be a central concern in the field. Using corpora in the classroom is based on having teachers and learners focus on how language is actually used in real contexts, rather than on carefully-crafted examples of language. In this course, we will explore how corpora can be used in language research, how language can be described using corpora, and how the findings from corpus analysis can be brought to the classroom in meaningful ways.
